



## **HMC sets course: the right care in the right place**

**To provide good care to residents of the Haaglanden region, both now and in the future: that is Haaglanden Medical Centre's (HMC) mission. To guarantee this, we are responding to changes in healthcare and society, and we are going to organise healthcare differently: nearby if possible, in the hospital if necessary. Together with GPs and home care organisations, we are going to organise care in a more community-focused way. Among other things, this means that, within three to five years, HMC will offer clinical care from two locations: HMC Antoniushove and HMC Westeinde. This is not yet the case though. What will change for you in the short term, and what do you need to know before visiting our hospital?**

### **HMC Bronovo: a week hospital per 2 July**

As of 2 July 2019, HMC Bronovo will become a week hospital. This is where elective care will take place: care that is needed but doesn't have to be provided immediately. You can also contact your trusted care provider in the outpatient clinic for things such as prenatal checkups or a checkup with your specialist. You can also visit HMC Bronovo for blood collection and radiological examination. Our team of doctors and nurses are available for you from Monday morning to Friday afternoon. HMC Bronovo is closed on the weekends.

### **Closure of Accidents & Emergency Department and GP out-of-hours service at HMC Bronovo**

The Accidents & Emergency Department (A&E) at HMC Bronovo will close as of 2 July 2019. From that date on, the A&E will be located at HMC Westeinde. You can go there for all emergency care.

Childbirth will move to HMC Westeinde as of 15 June 2019.

On 2 July 2019, the GP out-of-hours service will move from HMC Bronovo to HMC Antoniushove. You can contact the GP out-of-hours service in the evening and weekend on 070 346 96 69.



### **HMC Westeinde: centre for acute care**

All acute and highly complex treatments will take place at this location. You can also come here for emergency care during pregnancy and for childbirth. You are also welcome at HMC Westeinde for outpatient treatment from your trusted care team, for blood collection and for radiological examination.

### **HMC Antoniushove: outpatient care, oncological care and GP out-of-hours service**

Not much will change for visitors to HMC Antoniushove in the coming years. You can continue to visit this location for outpatient visits, blood testing and radiology, as you are used to. In addition, HMC, together with the LUMC, provides top-level oncological care from the Leiden-The Hague University Cancer Centre. As of 2 July 2019, the GP out-of-hours service will be moved to HMC Antonishove.

### **Renovation and modernisation**

To achieve our plans, we will be modifying and renovating our locations in the coming years. We will start with the renovation of HMC Westeinde; in the longer term, we will also further modernize HMC Antoniushove.

### **Check the location of your appointment carefully, and arrive on time**

Due to construction and (temporary) relocations, some appointments may take place at a different location than you are used to. To avoid mix-ups, please check your appointment letter carefully to see which HMC location your appointment is scheduled at.
