Top clinical teaching hospital

We are the principal city hospital for the metropolitan region of The Hague and provide a comprehensive range of care. As a top clinical teaching hospital, HMC has many areas of expertise and we offer specialised care through various centres and partnerships. In doing so, we are careful to take into account the care needs of vulnerable elderly people as a result of an increasingly ageing population. Our key priorities are our Trauma Centre and Neuro Centre. At our HMC Cancer Centre, we offer first-rate clinical cancer care.

- With one of the largest accident and emergency departments in the Netherlands, HMC is able to accommodate patients for every conceivable type of care 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Our HMC Trauma Centre is a regional Level 1 multi-trauma centre: the numberone centre for highly complex acute care and acute interventions at the highest level. This is what we are known for and what we invest in the most, in collaboration with the HagaZiekenhuis and the LUMC.
- At present, patients already travel to the HMC Neuro Centre from far and wide for treatment.
 Specialists at the Neuro Centre treat illnesses and neurological disorders of the brain, spine,
 nerves, spinal cord and muscles. In the years to come, we will continue to invest in this highly
 complex and highly specialised type of care with the latest techniques and treatments, partly
 in collaboration with LUMC.
- At our HMC Cancer Centre, we offer high-quality care for cancer patients. We stand out
 through quality and accessibility and work alongside the LUMC to provide excellent clinical
 cancer care. Patients travel to us from all over the world to receive care from a number of rare
 types of cancer.

Care closer to patients' homes.

We offer care both at our hospital and increasingly provide care closer to patients' homes. In addition to an outpatient site in Wassenaar, we offer clinical and outpatient care at three hospital sites – HMC Antoniushove, HMC Bronovo (weekday for plannable care) and HMC Westeinde – and will continue to do so until at least 2024. In the intervening years, we will be consolidating to two hospital sites: HMC Westeinde and HMC Antoniushove. We will be renovating and modernising these sites in the years to come.



Digital care

We are investigating what innovative care we will be offering in the HMC Bronovo catchment area and in Wassenaar, both in the district, at (GP) surgeries and at people's homes. We are also looking at how we can offer healthcare in a more digital form. All of this is carried out in consultation with our partners in our regional healthcare network. After all, providing appropriate care and creating a suitable environment for patients is a collective endeavour.

Our people

As a teaching hospital, we train employees, conduct research and exchange knowledge with healthcare providers in the region. We believe it is crucial that employees are able to contribute to improving care, with the input of nurses being essential in this regard. We invest in job satisfaction, thus ensuring that HMC is able to remain an attractive employer.
